

Andrew Mainz and his wife Lisa, in their Frederick shop, Accessories of Old, specialize in vintage (but unused, still in original packaging) fashion accessories purchased mostly in Europe before or shortly after World War II. Their amazing collection includes Czech glass beads, Swarovski crystal, glass and Lucite buttons, French sequins, rhinestone buckles, and much, much more. Emily Parker – Lost Wax Casting

Emily Parker has been making jewelry for most of her life, starting with watermelon seeds and glass stones with inlaid butterfly wings at age nine. She's moved on from that, with the help of classes and workshops at East Carolina University and Arrowmont School of Crafts, and with various jewelers she admires – but her first teacher was her mother, an artist with a custom jewelry business.

These days she uses a variety of techniques, such as lost wax casting, precious metal clay, hand fabrication, bead weaving, or assemblage, depending on what she wants to achieve in a particular piece and what she's planning to use in it. She explained how she makes that decision and what it's based on, with examples of pieces in various stages of completion. Then she demonstrated the process of lost wax casting, from start to ... well, not quite to finish; the actual casting is done by companies that specialize in that (but she told us where to go!).
